West Midlands firms can bid for share of £200m growth fund cash

WEST Midlands businesses can bid for a share of £200 million, the Deputy Prime Minister announced as he launched round six of the Regional Growth Fund (RGF).

Local companies which have already had support from the RGF:

- Goodwin PLC, a Stoke-on-Trent engineering group, is using its £2 million RGF grant to help the 130-year-old company expand, with 147 jobs due to be created by 2020. The company is building a new facility and 75 of the 125 apprentices scheduled to be trained during the project have already been employed.
- Bladon Jets is using its £3.1 million RGF grant at the company's Coventry R&D facility to fund 20 new high-value research jobs and to acquire specialised research and development equipment intended to put Bladon Jets at the forefront of micro gas turbine power generation technology.

To help bidders on their applications, roadshows and expression of interest days will be held throughout the country to provide advice on how to make a successful bid. On July 29 an event will be held at the University of Coventry.
